■ What we would like you to do

- · Shooting a video
 - Please do not add any background music and caption to your video.
- · Photos (face photo of JA)
 - Make sure there is enough light to click photo. Avoid dark environment/dark room.
 - Try to take photos in many patterns so that it will be easy for us to choose the best one.
 - Selected photo will be uploaded in website along with video.
- Script
 - Please write script of what was said during the video and submit it along with the video and photos.
- The following information will be posted on the website: video, photo, first name, age at the time /of shooting, and city of residence.

■Key Points for Shooting

- Camera (smartphone) in <u>landscape mode</u>. DO NOT shoot video in vertical mode.
- · Shooting time is about 1 to 2 minutes.
- · You can split it up and shoot it separately.
- Say your dialogue slowly and clearly.
- $\star \underline{\text{Do not use the zoom function}}$ when taking close-ups, but approach the subject with the camera.
